

## 2022 Black Betty

Black Betty is our light red. Named after the first sheep born in our vineyards the blend changed over time as Betty grew up and older. Domina - a crossing of Blauer Portugieser and Spätburgunder - and Regent - a hybrid crossing of Diana (Müller-Thurgau x Silvaner) and Chambourcin - define this blend. We press the Regent bunches directly and pour it over the Domina bunches picked shortly after for just a touch of color and tannin extraction before pressing a few days later.

The wines age in big old oak barrels before they get racked the following summer and blended with a small but noticeable batch of carbonic Spätburgunder making an incredibly juicy, glou-glou-style wine.

Vinification	Regent bunches pressed directly and poured over the Domina bunches, pressed after 3 days; Spätburgunder carbonic maceration (whole bunches in direct press juice) for 6 days
Ageing	1.200l oak barrels (Domina, Regent), stainless steel (Spätburgunder)
Bottling	October 2023
Alcohol	11%%
Acids	6 g/l
Residual sugar	0,5 g/l
Natural SO2	7 mg/l
