

Vater & Sohn #7

The Vater & Sohn (German for "father and son") is our white wine blend. Müller-Thurgau — a crossing of Riesling and Madeleine Royale — forms the base; the remaining varieties refine and add depth.

#7: Müller-Thurgau 69%, Silvaner 12%, Schwarzriesling (Pinot Meunier) 7%, Piwis 5% (field blend of hybrids), Frentsch (field-blend of old varieties) 2%, Spätburgunder (Pinot Noir) 2%, Bacchus 2%. All grown on shell limestone in and around Kitzingen, Franken. Grapes pressed directly after harvest, fermented fermented and aged in old oak barrels and stainless steel.

For #7 we blended three vintages to achieve the best possible balance: 2023, 2024 and 2025.

The name is a memory of, and homage to, the time when Michael and his father still worked on blends together.
